Every project requires a record book. **For 4-H purposes, Juniors are age 8-10, Intermediate 11-13, and senior 14+ as of December 31, 2018.** Many projects have supplemental sheets required for the record books so please read all the way through the lists. It is important that ALL youth including livestock use these record books and not the county records from prior years. They can be found at:
