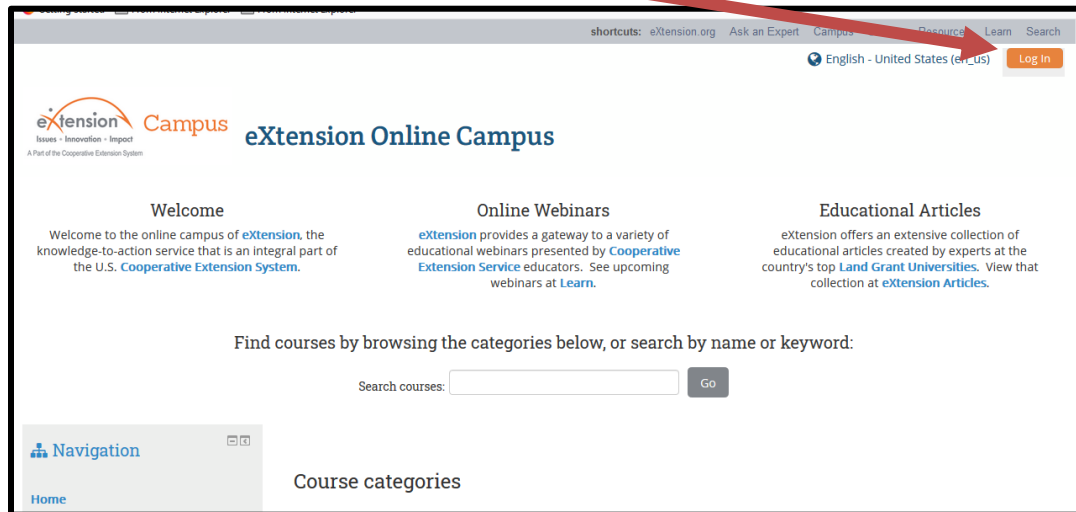
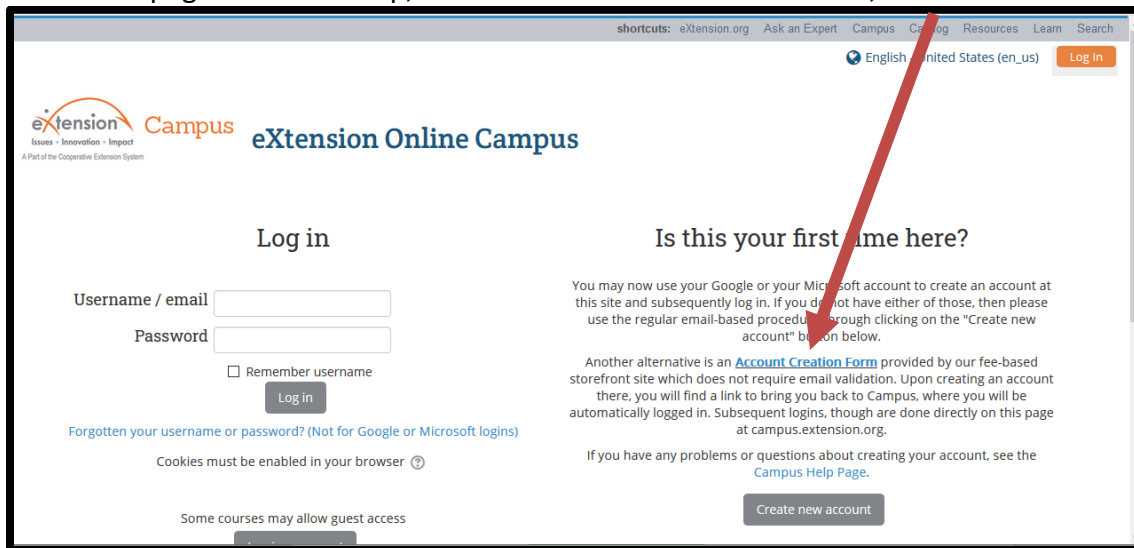


Directions to enroll in: Colorado 4-H Volunteers Orientation

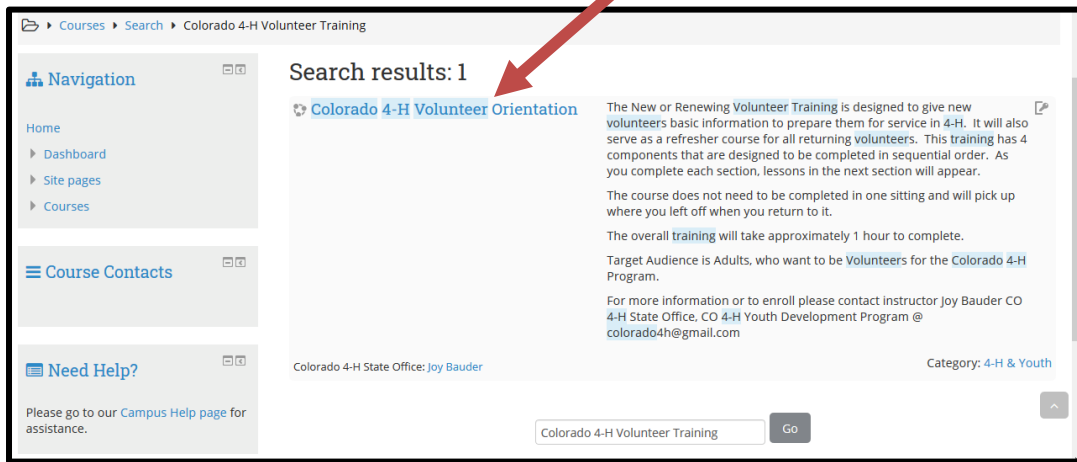

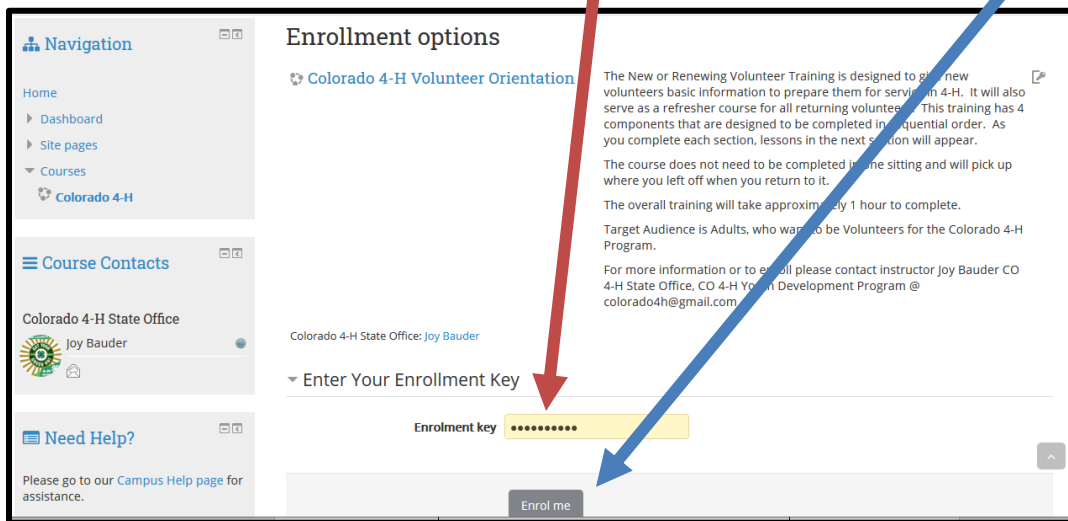
