



2020 Teller County 4-H Virtual Livestock Auction

1. First you will need to go to the 32auctions web link above where you can see all about our auction and look at the auction items (market livestock). You can access the auction items by clicking on the “**View All Items**” on the top left or very bottom of the page.



2. To actually bid on an item, or look at more of the details, you'll have to register. The easiest way to do this is to click on one of the auction items and you'll get this link to **create an account**:



3. That will take you to this screen where you just fill out the information and you're ready to go. Please **make sure to use an email you will check** because the auction sends bid information, including when you've been outbid and if you've won an auction to that email.

4. Now you're ready to bid on the market animal. You have two choices as far as making a bid. You can make an **exact** bid which will show what you are actually bidding. You can also make a **proxy** bid, which allows you to place a maximum amount you would like to pay. The auction will take the current bid and add the **minimum bid increment** (for steers it is \$200) so that you are the current high bidder. If someone bids above what you current bid is, then the system will automatically bid on your behalf up to your proxy bid. **Note that the proxy bid is shadowed out. To make it the active button, just click on it.**

All bids have been removed and the leading bidder has been notified.



5. Here's an example of how a **proxy bid** would work using Brendan's example above. Let's say you click on "**proxy bid**" and enter \$4,000 and click **place my bid**. You will become the high bidder at \$1,500 and the system will show the next minimum bid as \$1,700 (the \$1,500 bid plus the \$200 minimum increment bid). Let's say that another bidder goes in and places an exact bid of \$2,000 for this steer. The system will automatically update your bid to \$2,200 (the \$2,000 bid from the other buyer plus the \$200 minimum increment). If the auction stops here, you will be the winning bidder at a price of \$2,200. If though, someone else decided to continue bidding up the price, this same process will play out until it reaches your \$4,000 proxy bid. Once that price is exceeded, the system will send you an email letting you know that someone has outbid you on the item and give you a link to go back and increase your bid if you would like. The nice thing about the proxy bid is it allows you to establish the maximum price you are willing to pay and the system will bid for you, always advancing the current bid by only the minimum amount. You'll only get an email if someone has bid past your proxy amount so you're not getting inundated with emails each time you're outbid.



6. Once the auction is finished (5:00 p.m. Sunday, August 2), the auction will automatically email the winners with an email and an invoice. The Teller County Association of Fairs and Shows (TCAFAS) will also send you an invoice via the email you signed up with. We are asking that you send in a check rather than a credit card, and that you try to take care of payment at your earliest convenience since none of the kids are paid until we receive all the funds. If you need to use a credit card, please reach out to Terri Snare at 719-641-6261 and we can process those for you. We ask if using a credit card that you would be willing to take on the processing fee (typically around 3%) so the kids aren't penalized for it. Just to let you know, neither TCAFAS nor Extension takes any fee or percentage of the sale. Everything goes to the kids! That is pretty rare in any auction.
7. The final thing we want to make you aware of is that due to Covid-19, Rick's Processing has been backlogged with other fairs who changed dates and auctions. So, our auction ends August 2 and we don't take the animals to Ricks until August 16. That means all the animals will be fed for an additional two weeks past the auction and will be a little more finished than at the auction.
