

2025 Teller County CSU Extension Gardening/Landscaping Classes

Class 1: March 24 Soils, Fertilizers, and Mulch

Presented by a Master Gardener (TBD)

Proper soil balance is the key to a successful garden. This class will present soil characteristics, soil testing, and the difference between compost and fertilizers as well as the use of mulch.

Class 2: March 31 Seed Starting and Container Gardening

Presented by Teller County Master Gardeners Jana Bartlett and Barry Jensen Get a jump on the growing season by learning how to start seeds early indoors with proper seed starting techniques and timing. The second half of the class will focus on how to grow in containers, which is ideal for small spaces and beginner gardeners.

Class 3: April 7 What Grows Up Here?

Wondering about what vegetables, flowers, and landscaping plants do well in our area? Val will offer many options for you to consider, and you will receive a list of plants that grow successfully in Teller County.

Class 4: April 14 Water Law and Rain Barrels, Small Fruit Production

Presented by Teller County Master Gardeners Barry Jensen and Brian Elzas

Capturing rain water is legal in Colorado with some caveats. Learn what those are and how to make your own inexpensive rain barrel. Additionally, Brian will talk about what small fruits do well or those that at least have a chance here in Teller County (yes, you CAN grow some fruits here).

Class 5: April 21 Season Extending Techniques and Greenhouses

Presented by Teller County Master Gardeners Jana Bartlett and Barry Jensen Want to start gardening earlier and extend the season later? This class covers ways to accomplish this. The benefits and challenges of greenhouse gardening will also be presented.

Class 6: April 28 Fire Ignition Zones, Forest Insects and Diseases

Presented by Colorado State Forest Service

The Colorado State Forest Service will discuss how to protect your property from wildfire. Insects and diseases currently in the area and how to control them will also be covered.
